

15. PROGRAMME SELECTION AND SPECIAL FEATURES

ON/OFF button

 To turn the appliance on and off, press the ON/OFF button (for at least 3 seconds).

At the end of the cycle, remember to switch off the appliance using the ON/OFF button, then remove the plug and close the water supply.

First time you switch on the appliance

- Connect the machine to the power supply.
- Open the door, put the dishes to be washed inside, and close the door again.
- Press the "ON/OFF" button and hold for about 3 seconds.
- At this time only the "ON/OFF" and "Progr." buttons will be active, and all the programme indicator lights will come on for 3 sec. After this only indicator light "P3" will stay on, and all the buttons will still be active.
- Choose a programme with the "PROGRAMME SELECTION" button.
- If you wish to select an option, press the corresponding button (the indicator light representing the selected option will come on).
- Press "Start/Reset" and a signal will sound, the indicator light corresponding to the selected programme will stay on and the wash indicator light will come on.
- Close the door (after an audible signal has sounded, the programme will start automatically).

Next time you switch on the appliance

- Open the door.
- Hold down the ON/OFF button for about 3 sec. to turn the machine on, and the "P3"programme indicator light will come on.

If you have turned on the programme memorisation function, the indicator light corresponding to the last programme completed will appear on the display.

Settings Menu

From the Settings menu, you can adjust various parameters to suit your washing requirements.

Entering the Settings menu

- Open the door.
- Turn on the dishwasher by holding the "ON/OFF" button down for about 3 sec.
- Hold down the "Progr." and "ON/OFF" buttons for about 5 sec.
- All the indicator lights will flash for 5 sec.
- The settings will be displayed:
- Lime scale prevention settings appear when the indicator light comes on in the corresponding programmes. If they are all off, the level is set to "S0".
- When the audio signal is activated, the "Express" indicator light comes on.
- When the "Memo" function is activated, the "6h" indicator light on the start delay function comes on.
- When you press the "Progr." button, adjustment of SOFTENER will begin (refer to the appropriate chapter in the instruction booklet for information).
- Press the "Express" button to turn on adjustment of the BUZZER. (refer to the section on this topic for information on how to adjust).

 Press the "Start Delay" button to activate the MEMO FUNCTION (refer to the appropriate chapter in the instruction booklet for information on how to turn it on and off).

"AUTOMATIC" programmes (only on some models)

The dishwasher is equipped with a dirt sensor, capable of analysing water murkiness during all "AUTOMATIC" programme phases (see programme legend). Thanks to this device, the wash cycle parameters are automatically adapted to the real quantity of dirt on dishes. This is because water murkiness is linked to the quantity of dirt on dishes. Thus, excellent washing results are guaranteed while optimising water and energy consumption.

"IMPULSE" programmes (only on some models)

The "IMPULSE" programmes use an impulse washing technology, which reduces consumption and noise, and improves performance.

The "intermittent" working of the washing pump is NOT to be considered a malfunction; it is a characteristic of impulse washing, and therefore should be considered a normal feature of the programme.

ADDISH (possibility of adding dishes after the programme has started)

When the programme starts, you should only open the door and add more dishes when the ADDISH indicator light is switched on. The appliance will stop automatically and the time remaining to the end of the cycle will flash on the display. Close the door, without pressing any buttons.

The cycle will start from where it left off. When the relating indicator light switches off, it is no longer advisable to add further dishes. Open the door slowly and carefully, to avoid getting wet with splashes of washing water.

Adding dishes after the ADDISH indicator light has switched off is strongly discouraged as this could affect the wash performance.



WARNING

If you open the door during the drying cycle, an intermittent audio signal advises you that the drying cycle has not yet finished.

Programme interruption

Opening the door when a programme is running is not recommended especially during the main wash and final hot rinse phases. However, if the door is opened while a programme is running (for example, to add dishes) the machine stops automatically. Close the door, without pressing any buttons. The cycle will start from where it left off.



WARNING:

If you open the door during the drying cycle, an intermittent audio signal advises you that the drying cycle has not yet finished.

Changing a running programme.

Proceed as follows to change or cancel a running program:

- Open the door.
- Hold the "Start/Reset" button down for at least 3 seconds.
- Some audible signals will sound and the programme indicator lights will turn on and off individually and sequentially.

- The running programme will be cancelled and all the programme indicator lights will flash.
- At this point a new programme can be set.



WARNING:

Before starting a new programme, you should check that there is still detergent in the dispenser. If necessary, top up the dispenser.

Programme operations.

When a programme is running the relevant indicator light will remain on and the 3 "PROGRAMME STATUS" indicator lights:

WASH &

RINSE A

DRY !!!

will light singularly and in sequence to indicate the current phase.

If there is any break in the power supply while the dishwasher is operating, a special memory stores the selected programme and, when the power is restored, it continues where it left off.

Programme end

A 5 second buzzer will sound (if not muted) 3 times at 30 second intervals to signal that the programme has ended.

Option buttons

The option buttons provide you with further wash options, allowing you to customise the wash programmes (see the table in chapter 17 for a list of programmes on which each option can be enabled). Options are enabled (or disabled) before starting the programme, using the appropriate buttons. The relevant indicator lights will appear (or disappear) on the display. The option button should be enabled after you have chosen the wash programme.

If an option is selected that is not compatible with the selected programme then the option indicator light first flashes and then goes off.

"Express" button

This button enables average energy and time savings of 25% (according to the cycle selected), reducing the wash water temperature and the drying time during the final rinse. This option is recommended for evening washing when perfectly dry dishes are not needed immediately.

For better drying, leave the dishwasher door slightly ajar to promote natural air circulation in the dishwasher.

"NO SALT" indicator light

This model is provided with an indicator light on the control panel that lights up when the salt needs to be topped up. The appearance of whitish stains on dishes is generally a warning sign that the salt container needs filling.

"RESET" button for "NO SALT" indicator light

After filling the salt container, you should press this button for a few seconds, until the corresponding indicator light switches off.



WARNING:

If you press the reset button without filling the salt container, this will interfere with the correct functioning of the salt indicator light.

In order to guarantee the correct functioning of the salt indicator light, YOU MUST ALWAYS FULLY REPLENISH THE SALT CONTAINER.

"START DELAY" button

The dishwasher start time can be set with this button, delaying the start by 3, 6 or 9 hours.

Proceed as follows to set a delayed start:

- Open the door.
- Choose a programme by pressing the "PROGRAMME SELECTION" button.
- Press the "START DELAY" button (each time the button is pressed the start will be delayed by 3, 6 or 9 hours respectively, and the corresponding time indicator light will switch on).
- To start the countdown, press the "Start/Reset" button (the set time indicator light will start to flash).

If a 9 hour delay is set, countdown will be displayed by the 6h indicator light after 3 hours and the 3h indicator light after 6 hours.

At the end of the last 3 hours (at the end of countdown) the 3h indicator light will stop flashing and remain on to indicate the washing phase and the programme will start automatically.

If countdown has not ended, whereby the programme has not yet started, it is possible to change or cancel the delayed start and select another programme or to select/deselect the option button, proceeding as follows:

- Hold the "Start/Reset" button down for at least 3 seconds. Some audible signals will sound and the programme indicator lights will turn on and off individually and sequentially.
- The delayed start and the selected programme will be cancelled. The programme indicator lights will flash, the dishwasher is ready start Programme.

Activation/Muted END-OF-PROGRAMME signal.

You can deactivate turning on and off of the audio signal as follows (the default setting is active):

- Open the door.
- Turn on the dishwasher by pressing the "ON/OFF" button for about 3 sec.
- Hold down the "Progr." and "ON/OFF" buttons for about 5 sec.
- All the indicator lights will flash for 5 sec.
- If the audio signal is active, the "Express" indicator light will be on.
- If the audio signal is not active, the "Express" indicator light will be off.
- Press the "Express" button to turn the audio signal on or off.
- Whenever the audio signal is turned on, in addition to visual confirmation given by turning on the "Express" led, an acoustic signal will sound as confirmation.
- If you turn off the audio signal, no audio signal will sound to accompany the visual confirmation when the "Express" led goes off.
- Turn off the dishwasher by holding down the "ON/OFF" button for about 3 sec. to make the new setting effective.

MEMO FUNCTION (Memorising the last programme used)

Proceed as follows to enable storage of the last programme used in memory:

- Open the door.
- Turn on the dishwasher by pressing the "ON/OFF" button for about 3 sec.
- Hold down the "Progr." and "ON/OFF" buttons for about 5 sec.
- All the indicator lights will flash for 5 sec.

- 1. The "6h" indicator light on the "Start 3. Turn off the dishwasher by holding down Delay" function is off by default.
- 2. When you press the "Start Delay" button, the "6h" indicator light will come on and an audio signal will sound.
- the "ON/OFF" button for about 5 sec. to make the new setting effective.

Follow the same procedure to turn off the memory.

Programme			Description			
P1	Ė	Intensive	Once a day - for heavily soiled pans and any other items that have been left all day for washing.			
P2	亡	Universal	Once a day - for normal soiled pans and any other items that have been left all day for washing.			
Р3	ECO	Eco	Programme for normally soiled tableware (the most efficient in terms of its combined energy and water consumption for that type of tableware). Programme standardised to EN 50242.			
P4	<u>//\</u>	Prewash	Short cold prewash for items that are stored in the dishwasher until you are ready to wash a full load.			
P5	39.0	Rapid 39'	Fast cycle, suitable for heavily soiled items that are to be washed straight after a meal (Max 8 place load).
